UK-based Zodiac Maritime Agencies's safety management is set to come under investigation again following a serious accident involving its general cargoship *Seagate* (built 1989).

The vessel collided with the Liberia-flag, 535,112-cbf reefer *Timor Sea* (built 1998) some 96 kilometres (60 miles) north-east of Isle de Tortue off Haiti. It sustained heavy damage to its superstructure and 18 of a crew of 21 abandoned ship.

A general cargo ship was severely damaged early Saturday after being involved in a major collision with a reefer ship in the Caribbean Sea.

The collision occurred early Saturday between the 557-foot U.K.-flagged *M/V Seagate* (pictured) and the 492-foot Liberian-flagged *M/V Timor Stream* off the northeast coast of Tortuga, Haiti.
