11 JULY 2003: At Kvaerner Warnow Werft (KWW in future Aker Warnow Werft) in Rostock-Warnemünde (Germany) the third container vessel in 2003 of KWW's own development WARNOW CV 2500 was delivered on Thursday (July 10). The container vessel with yard number 032 was delivered to the single ship company SPC NB 32 Schiffahrtsgesellschaft mbH in Hamburg and is the first of four vessels which will be operated by the major German ship owner Rudolf A. Oetker KG Hamburg under long-term bareboat charters. It will be named CAP CARMEL on Friday (July 11) offshore Warnemünde

The ship will leave the yard with destination U.S. East coast to start a several years bareboat charter for German ship owner Reederei Rudolf A. Oetker Hamburg belonging to the Hamburg Süd group. The ship management for this vessel will be carried out by Columbus Shipmanagement GmbH, subsidiary of Hamburg Süd. CAP CARMEL will take over a complete loading of empty containers at U.S. East coast for Far East. After completion of this intermediate service the vessel will be integrated into a regular service of Hamburg Süd between Far East and the East coast of South America.
