

A2B-online buys its largest ship

Anglo - Dutch intra Europe short - sea regional carrier A2B-online has purchased the 658 teu PHOENIX II and renamed her A2B INDEPEND-ENT. The ship will be modified to adapt it for the specific short - sea cargo mix of A2B Moerdijk-UK services, which she is expected to join at the end of the summer.

The A2B INDEPENDENT is the fourth and largest owned vessel for the North Sea carrier who started operating between the Netherlands and the UK in June 2013. She is expected to replace the smaller 326 teu VANQUISH, chartered three months ago. The three other A2B-owned ships are the 508 teu A2B ENERGY and A2B FUTURE (both purchased in 2015) and A2B COMFORT (purchased in January 2016), all of the Sietas 'Typ 151'.

Akkon buys the A2B INDEPENDENT (658 teu)

Akkon Lines of Turkey this month acquired the gearless 658 teu container ship A2B INDEPENDENT from

the Netherlands-based short sea container carrier A2B Online. A sales price has not been reported.

The ice-classed (1A) vessel was built by the J.J. Sietas shipyard of Hamburg in 1998. She was launched for the German owners Ernst Russ under the name ANTJE RUSS.

As a 'Typ 160a' the A2B INDEPENDENT is a variant of the popular 'Typ 160' of which J.J. Sietas built 14 units from 1996 to 1990. In contrast to the 'Typ 160', which features a central open-top hold, the otherwise very similar six 'Typ 160a' ships come equipped with hatch covers on all holds.

The vessel is 118.50 m long and 18.20 m wide. It is powered by an MAN-B&W - 8 L40/54 main engine that develops 5,760 kW and drives the ship at a speed of 17 knots.

The A2B INDEPENDENT has spent most of her recent years shuttling between Moerdijk in the Netherlands and the UK port of Immingham, with occasional trips to other UK ports.

Akkon Lines will soon position the ship from Rotterdam to the Med, where she will join the carrier's Turkey - Italy - Casablanca service under the new name DEPE.
