GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

The first conventional reefer load of ZESPRITM kiwifruit left the Port of Tauranga for Japan this week, with a further seven charter vessels scheduled to sail during April.

Zespri chartered about 70 reefer vessels for the European, Asian and North American markets annually, with a further 14,000 40-foot containers servicing marketing contracts in other parts of the world, he said.

ASIAN CHERRY, a Fresh Carriers Corporation line vessel, left this week with 350,000 trays of ZESPRITM kiwifruit, while the fully loaded vessels carry up to 1.4 million trays each.
