GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

The **BOW LION** (Norwegian-registry 22,637-gt, 40,272-dwt tanker, owned and operated by Storli A.S.A.) spilled about a ton of a poisonous liquid on 9 Feb. off Kobe, Japan. The ship, with a crew of 23 Filipino and six Greek citizens, had arrived in Kobe from Houston with a cargo of 35,000 tons of chemicals, including 6,000 tons of styrene monomer for Taiwan. The **BOW LION** left Kobe 11 Feb. for Ulsan, South Korea, before sailing to Taiwan.
