GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

Third vessel of 9 vessel series delivered to Columbia Shipmanagement (H. Schoeller), Limassol / Hamburg. Four vessels (**CAPE DYER**, CAPE DARNLEY, CAPE DORCHESTER & GOLDEN ISLE (ex CAPE DONNINGTON) were bought by Emissionshaus Lloyd Fonds AG for US \$ 23 mio each and have been offered to German investment capital market (project name of CAPE DYER is now SAN ANTONIO)

The M/V CAPE DYER, owned by Project Asia of Australia, made its maiden voyage to Kaohsiung Port on Aug.25,2002, docking at Berth 37. The Deputy Director Mr. Teng welcomed the ship by presenting a KaoPort plaque. The M/V **CAPE DYER** is the third D-class vessel of Project Asia of Australia. The previous two also made their maiden voyages to Kaohsiung Port. According to the announcement of Kaos Enterprise Ltd(Project Asia of Australia's agency in Taiwan): Project Asia of Australia commenced its Australia-Asia route in 1998, with fortnightly services carrying lead, zinc, and aluminum, etc to Kaohsiung, and loading containers and general cargo for the return trip to Australia's major ports. CAPE DYER with around 10,000-tons of minerals on board left for Pusan Port in Korea on Aug.26, 2002, and it will continue on the Australia-Asia shipping route in the immediate future

Sold to NSC Schiffahrtsges. mbH KG, Germany (owned by R. Echevarria v. Gusovios) en bloc with CAPE DARNLEY / CAPE DELFARO / CAPE DELGADO / CAPE DONNINGTON & CAPE DORCHESTER. Renamed CCNI MAGALLANES. Three ships of the 9 vessel series are still operated by Columbia Shipmanagement (H. Schoeller), but now owned by the German financial company Emissionshaus König & Cie.
