GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

On the 7th of October the Christening Ceremony of two PRISCO Aframax tankers was held at the Hyundai Heavy Industries Shipyard, Republic of Korea. Primorsk Shipping Corporation (PRISCO) builds three tankers at this shipyard. Two of the series named Pavel Chernysh and **CAPTAIN KOSTICHEV** have been blessed by Bishop of the Uzhno-Sakhalinsk and Kuril Eparchy Daniil in accordance with Russian Orthodox traditions.

The tanker Viktor Titov, owned by Primorsk Shipping Corporation (PRISCO), is to sail from the port of De Kastri in Khabarovsk territory on October 15-16 to deliver the first consignment of Sakhalin-1 oil to Japan. This consignment amounts to 100,000 tons. Another PRISCO tanker - the **CAPTAIN KOSTICHEV** - will arrive in De Kastri in November to work for the Sakhalin-1 project. This tanker is currently transporting liquid freight to the Asia-Pacific region. A third tanker - the Pavel Chernysh, which is currently in Singapore, will arrive in December. All three PRISCO tankers will operate under a time-charter with Sakhalin-1 operator Exxon Neftegas Limited for 10 years.
