2009:**Samama/Zodiac acquires 10 Eastwind boxships ...**

The Ofer-owned Samama has acquired 10 former Eastwind containerships, under a 13 ship deal with Nordea Bank. Nordea had earlier foreclosed on the financially troubled Eastwind's subsidiaries and taken control of the ships. Samama's affiliate, Zodiac Maritime will manage the ships on its behalf.

The 10 containerships were built between 1983 and 1992 and range in size from 570 to 2,100 teu. Two 30,000 tdw bulkers and a 279,000 cbf reefer ship EW Kenya are also included in the deal. No price for the transaction was disclosed. All the 10 containerships were acquired by Eastwind in 2006/7 and are currently chartered, including 4 fully refrigerated containerships chartered to Great White Fleet up to 2010-2014.

Eastwind had subsequently filed for Chapter 7 bankruptcy protection in New York last Wednesday. The company still owns 6 more containerships in its fleet of over 50 ships but these assets will now be liquidated by a court-appointed administrator following its bankruptcy filing.
