Technomar Shipping of Greece has purchased the 5,551 teu RIO BLACK-WATER from interests linked to Ahrenkiel Steamship GmbH of Germany, for a price believed to be USD 10 M.

The vessel has been renamed ZOI under Liberian flag. She is currently off Manila. It is unclear if the ship has a charter in place although she had been rumoured fixed to CMA CGM.

The RIO BLACKWATER was built in 2000 by South Korea's Hyundai Heavy Industries (HHI), originally for Costamare Shipping. She features a deadweight of 68,100 tons, a Loa of 275 metres and a beam of 40 meters. She is fitted with 550 reefer plugs.

The ship started her career with an eight-year charter to China Shipping Container Line (CSCL) as the CSCL SHANGHAI before being later traded on the charter market. She had been operated by Hapag-Lloyd in the last few years.
