Hanjin Shipping has sold two of its oldest containerships for scrap, as the number of vessels still under the carrier's control continues to fall.

The 5,302 teu HANJIN PARIS and the 4,024 teu HANJIN LOS ANGELES (both built in 1997) are expected to make their way to the Indian subcontinent shortly for demolition.

Financially troubled South Korean shipping company Hanjin Shipping has sold two container ships for demolition,

VesselsValue data shows. The vessels in question are the 5,302 TEU Post-Panamax boxship HANJIN PARIS and the 4,024 TEU Panamax vessel HANJIN LOS ANGELES. The 62,800 dwt (deadweight ton) HANJIN LOS ANGELES and the 67,300 dwt HANJIN PARIS were sold for USD 294/LTD (light displacement) and USD 289/LDT, respectively.

Market value of the HANJIN LOS ANGELES stands at USD 5.86 million and of the HANJIN PARIS at USD 7.98 million.
