Two 'Hanjin 1600' types escape demolition

Two 'Hanjin 1600' type container vessels formerly controlled by South Korean carrier SM Line, the 1,645 teu SM HOCHIMINH and the 1,585 teu SM BANGKOK, at one point reported sold for demolition, will finally continue trading, for now.

The SM HOCHIMINH has been sold to Middle East Interests and renamed LILA HOCHIMINH. The ship has secured a 7-10-month charter with Indonesian carrier Samudera at \$8,000 per day, for trading between Singapore, Port Kelang & Bangladesh. The SM HOCHIMINH was built in 1998 at the Hanjin Heavy Industries shippard in Ulsan, originally as the HANSA CENTURION for German owner Leonhard & Blumberg. She joined SM Line in 2017.

As for the SM BANGKOK, she has been sold to Greek owner Victoria Oceanway Ltd and renamed BANGKOK. She is currently in Singapore, believed unfixed. The SM BANGKOK was built in 1999, originally as the KINDIA for OT Africa Line (OTAL), once a major name on the Europe - West Africa route that was subsequently sold to Delmas (and then to CMA CGM).

Both ships belong to the popular 'Hanjin 1600' series of which 22 units were built between 1994 and 2002. They feature a deadweight of 21, 000 tons, a LOA of 168 metres and a beam of 27.20 metres. The LILA HOCHIMINH is gearless while the BANG-KOK is geared. Despite their age, these ships remain popular in Asia thanks to their 'Bangkokmax' dimensions, which remain an attractive feature for many carriers. Their purchase for further trading is therefore a bold move. For Victoria Oceanway this acquisition particularly makes sense as the company already runs three 'Hanjin 1600' type vessels in its fleet, the 1997-built SOUL OF LUCK, STAR OF LUCK and the 2000-built SEA OF LUCK. All of them are traded on the charter market and currently operated in Asia.
