85-m, 2,240-gt Antigua/Barbuda-flagged cargo M/V WINDLAND (IMO 7431715) collided with 89-m Gibraltar-flagged tanker M/V KOESTERBERG (IMO 9184677) upon departing the port of Brake, Germany, on Sept. 18. Both ships have to stay in port until repairs are carried out. (Sat. Sept. 27 2008).
