**GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:**

POL America (Polish-registry 35,332-dwt containership built in 1975, operated by Mediterranean Shipping) lost 23 containers overboard this week in heavy winds and seas up to nine meters/30 feet off Nantucket Island, Mass. Most of containers apparently sank, but at least one, carrying candy, washed ashore on the eastern section of the island. Residents on 3 April reported finding thousands of Hershey Kisses, Tootsie Rolls and other candy. A clean-up operation was begun, with fears that the candy could affect right whales and other animals. Other containers carried a car, furniture and shoes. The Pol America sailed to Baltimore.
