GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

ESL acquired three vessels upon its establishment, in 1965. **Since then, its largest procurement was made during the military regime when the company ordered the building of ABYOT and ABAY WONZE in the UK and that of ANDINET and NETSANET from a shipyard in Italy.** (www.skyscrapercity.com - January 17th, 2011)

2011: **Ethiopian Shipping Lines orders 9 ships from China.** The Ethiopian national carrier has placed a contract for nine new ships at Chinese yards. **The order is for seven 28,000-ton heavy lift multipurpose vessels** at Shandong Huanghai Shipbuilding for \$32.5

million a piece and for two 41,500-ton tankers at Jinling Shipyard for \$37 million each. The multipurpose ships will be delivered from August 2012 and the last unit of the series is due in February 2014.

The new units will replace six cargo ships between 15,000 and 8,000 tons, built between 1984 and 1990.
