In early March, Zodiac snapped up a series of five 6,214-teu vessels from Japan's NYK Line. The NYK Antares (built 1997) and NYK Andromeda, NYK Castor, NYK Canopus and NYK Sirius (all built 1998) were acquired for around \$19m each, or \$95m in total.

The vessel was supposed to join the Far East-to-West Coast South America service operated jointly by MSC, CCNI and Hamburg Sud.

According to analysts Alphaliner, that service will continue with four of a group of five ships recently chartered by MSC from Zodiac Maritime Agencies, which had in turn just purchased them from NYK.

The 6,200-teu quartet are the *MSC Botswana*, *MSC Swaziland*, *MSC Zambia* and *MSC Mozambique* (all built 1998).

Idan Ofer-controlled Eastern Pacific Shipping sold its 1998-built 6,208 teu container ship *Mozambique* for USD398 per ldt after the vessel came off charter to Maersk Line.

Mediterranean Shipping Company (MSC) continued to clear out older vessels, selling the 1988-built 2,932 teu *MSC Alice* for USD390 per ldt.

Both vessels are said to be heading to India, where recyclers prefer container ships because of the suitable draught limits.

Idan Ofer's Eastern Pacific continues to send 1990s-built boxships for demolition. The 6,400-teu *Mozambique* (built 1998) has been sold for optional delivery for \$398 per ldt, or \$11.1m. Last week, the company sold the 6,342-teu containership *Botswana* (built 1998).
