GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

2006: The Saigon Shipbuilding Industry Company (SSIC) handed over Wednesday a 6,500 ton freighter to the Saigon Shipping Company. The **SAIGON QUEEN**, which cost \$7.2 million, is 103-m long and 17-m wide, and has a top speed of 23 km per hour, is the largest vessel built by the shipyard.. 2012: **SAIGON QUEEN*** (9364083), 4,074/06 - general cargo, owned by Saigon Shipping Joint Stock Co., Vietnam. **Sank 30/10/2012** when her cargo of timber shifted in heavy weather in the Bay of Bengal, 170 miles E of Batticaloa, Sri Lanka, **in position 07.59N, 84.07E**. The crew took to the liferafts but the captain was lost and three are missing. She was on passage from Yangon for India. (Marine News 01/2013)
