Titan Ocean flips tankers

Singapore's Titan Ocean is understood to have sold two medium-range (MR) products tankers from the Neptune Associated Shipping (NAS) fleet that it bought from Neptune Orient Lines earlier this month.

Market sources say the 47,000-dwt Eagle Vela and Eagle Sagitta (both built 1996) have been sold to Tanker Pacific, the Singapore arm of the Ofer group. Brokers estimated the value of the vessels at around \$52m in an en-bloc deal.

Idan Ofer-led Eastern Pacific Shipping is selling a 1990s-built medium-range (MR) tanker as part of its fleet-renewal programme.

The Onomichi Dockyard-built, 47,000-dwt Savannah (built 1996), which is due for special survey in April, has been sold to a Middle East-based buyer for \$8.3m.

Last week, a similar tanker, the 45,000-dwt Portland Pearl (built 1996), was reported sold to Winson Shipping of Taiwan for \$8.8m (see Winson tanker buys, facing page).

The Savannah must have been a cash cow for many years for the Ofer company, which bought it for \$26m in 2004 prior to the shipping boom.
