Frontline is clearing out bulkers

Frontline continues to clear out its bulkers and has sold its 50% stakes in the 47,000-dwt Golden Rose and Golden Daisy (both built 1998).

Ola Lorentzon, managing director of Frontline Management, confirms the stakes have been sold to company partner Samartzis of Greece. He declines to comment on the price but sources say the sale is based on that of the 45,000-dwt bulkers Golden Protea and Golden Aloe (both built 1998), which Frontline sold in May to Spar Shipping of Bergen for about \$14.5m

Spar Shipping wraps up clear-out of elderly bulkers

Spar Shipping of Bergen has sold the last of its 1990s-built bulkers and is now left with a fleet of 26 supramaxes trading, plus a newbuilding at China's Jiangsu Hantong Ship Heavy Industry that is set for delivery later this year.

The latest vessel to go is the Hashihama-built, 47,000-dwt *Spar Lupus* (built 1998), which is due for drydocking in August.

It went to an undisclosed buyer for \$2.3m, a price close to its demolition value.

The ship was bought from John Fredriksen's Golden Ocean Group as *Golden Aloe* in May 2002 for \$14.5m, together with the 45.000-dwt Spar Cetus (built 1998) at the same price.
