Tasman Orient Line (TOL), owned by C.F. Ahrenkiel & J. Swire (Singapore), has upgraded two of its services between New Zealand & Asia. South Asia route was transferred to three weekly service with two vessels. Port rotation is Whangarei, Tauranga, Wellington, Surabaya, Jakarta, Davao and Subic Bay. Vessels trading on this route are 660 teu **TASMAN COMMANDER** & **TASMAN**

CAMPAIGNER.

(AK 03+04/2002)

In July 2004 Tasman Orient Line said that it was implementing an East Asia and South East Asia service tonnage upgrade programme later in July. This followed the acquisition of the vessels **CHUNGKING** & **OCEANIC CHALLENGER** (both 18,468 gross tonnage, built 1995) for the South East Asia service and **TASMAN ENDEAVOUR** & **TASMAN PROVIDER** (both 18,451 gross tonnage, built 1994) for the East Asia service.

The vessels previously maintaining the service, **TASMAN COMMANDER** (13,911 gross tonnage, built 1984) and **TASMAN CAMPAIGNER** (13,911 gross tonnage, built 1985), were withdrawn from the South East Asia service and replaced.
