**GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:**

By interests associated with Reederei Erwin Strahlmann eK, Antigua and Barbuda to UAL Africa CV, Netherlands during fitting out Marine News 5/2012

Universal Africa Line (UAL) has taken in charge the 7,500 tdw multipurpose cargo vessel **UAL AFRICA** for assignment to its Europe-West Africa oil-industry-oriented multipurpose service. The **UAL AFRICA** offers a container intake of up to 265 teu in the absence of breakbulk cargoes and is fitted with two cranes of 60 tons combinable to lift 120 ton modules. She is chartered from Netherlands owner Nescos Shipping BV. The 119-metre ship is of Bodewes Shipyard's Eko-Trader type. This new design with its uniquely-shaped and distinctive 'cross' bow was developed to achieve a low block coefficient and thus a very low consumption. The shipyard claims that the 'cross' bow's wave-piercing abilities will lead to less slamming in high waves and will allow the vessel to maintain its speed more easily than conventional designs.
