2013: Today Makes Tomorrow (TMT) Group, a Taiwanese shipping company, filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection in Houston in June 2013. Following a failed restructuring of its billion debt and an industry downturn, TMT's fleet of 17 vessels was sold off, with many vessels arrested and laid up at ports.

2014: Arrested in China due to the bankruptcy of TMT Group.

2015: Renamed **JR SPRING** (Hubei Quintai Shipping Co Ltd, China).

2022: Renamed **TRUONG LONG 01** (Truong Long VN JSC, Vietnam).

2025: Sold to cash buyers and renamed **LONG 1** for demolition. Broken up in Chattogram, 22/05/2025.

Hyundai tracks down TMT ship in upriver Chinese port

Remnants of the fleet of Nobu Su are not being overlooked by maritime lawyers pressing worldwide claims, even in mainland China

Hyundai Heavy Industries (HHI) has caught another ship in the fleet of Today Makes Tomorrow (TMT) and is set to auction it through China's Wuhan Maritime Court.

The move comes after the successive auctions earlier this year of four recent-vintage HHI-built car carriers with proceeds upwards of \$220m.

The 55,600-dwt wood-chip carrier Admirar Vista (built 1990) is now at Zhenjiang on the Yangtze River.
