Zodiac buys up Hyundai box trio

The giant Ofer group is buying more boxships from a cash-strapped Korean.

Zodiac Maritime has pounced again to buy three post-panamax boxships from Korea's Hyundai Merchant Marine (HMM).

The London-based Ofer group shipmanagement company is said to be paying \$41m each for the 5,550-teu sisters Hyundai Independence, Hyundai Liberty and Hyundai Discovery (built 1996).

The ships will be chartered back to HMM for rates said to be in the low \$20,000s a day.

MSC boxship suffers fuel tank gash

The fuel tank of a 4,360 teu MSC boxship was badly ruptured yesterday morning as the vessel manouvered and hit a berth at a terminal belonging to Yilport in Turkey.

Oil dispersants were used and a boom was put around the ship and the oil spill was contained.

The 22-year-old vessel, the [MSC Katyayni](#), will now likely stay in Turkey for repairs. It is owned by Zodiac Maritime and managed by MSC.
